Pursuant to Section 284.13(d)(2) of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission's Regulations, each interstate pipeline providing transportation subject to the provision of Subpart A of Part 284 is required to submit an annual filing showing the total estimated peak day firm service capacity of the pipeline's system; the estimated storage capacity and maximum daily delivery capability of storage facilities under reasonably representative operating assumptions; and the respective assignments of that capacity to the various firm services provided by the pipeline.
